Norden 0–30

The Norden 0–30 funding programme exists to strengthen the organisation and influence of children and young people in political, social, and cultural contexts.



Norden 0–30



- For **organisations** (e.g., associations, municipalities), **working groups, and networks**.
- For initiatives with a focus on political, cultural, or social issues that engage **people aged 0 to 30**.
- Participation of at least **three Nordic** countries is required in projects where there is multi-country participation. Up to EUR **50,000** in funding can be applied for.
- Participation of at least **two Nordic countries** is required in projects involving **Greenland, Iceland, the Faroe Islands, or Åland**. In these instances, up to EUR **10,000** in funding can be applied for.



Example projects for Norden 0–30



- Nordic Climate Youth Network
- Three meetings and an international Climate Camp for people aged 16 to 29
- Finland, Denmark, Norway, Sweden



- Nordic youth conference on democracy and freedom of expression for young people aged 15 to 24
- Norway, Denmark, Sweden



- LEAD Sustainability
- Sustainability network for young people aged 18 to 30
- Norway, Denmark, Sweden

Demos - funding for civil society

For meetings and networks that strengthen the voice of civil society and provide organisations with opportunities to influence society.

Funding for joint Nordic projects to civil society organisations/associations

Projects that create networks and joint activities in the Nordic region



Demos



Funding can be applied for by **civil society organisations** in all areas of society.

Projects eligible for funding include:

- a series of **joint meetings, conferences, workshops, concerts, staff exchanges, and joint training**
- the facilitation and exchange of ideas and knowledge between different civil society organisations in the Nordic Region
- the start-up of more long-term collaborations

Funding of up to EUR 100,000 can be granted (up to 85% of the total budget).



Demos – now in three modules

- **Demos Network: [13.8-13.9.2024]**
For **meetings and networks** that strengthen the voice of civil society and provide organisations with opportunities to influence society.
- **Demos Learning: [12.3-12.4.2024]**
For Nordic projects that have a focus on **education, the sharing of knowledge, and language comprehension.**
- **Demos Culture: [12.3-12.4.2024]**
For projects that promote cultural collaboration in the Nordics with a special focus on orchestral **co-operation, musical interaction, and literature.**



Demos – main project criteria

- Minimum 3 project partners from 3 Nordic countries
- Civil society organisations
- Timeframe: Project start from 8 - 10 weeks after DL + 2 years
- In kind and administration can be included
- 85% of total budget can be funded
 - Vision 2030
 - Nordic added value
 - Long term collaboration
 - Sustainable development, gender equality and children and young people's rights

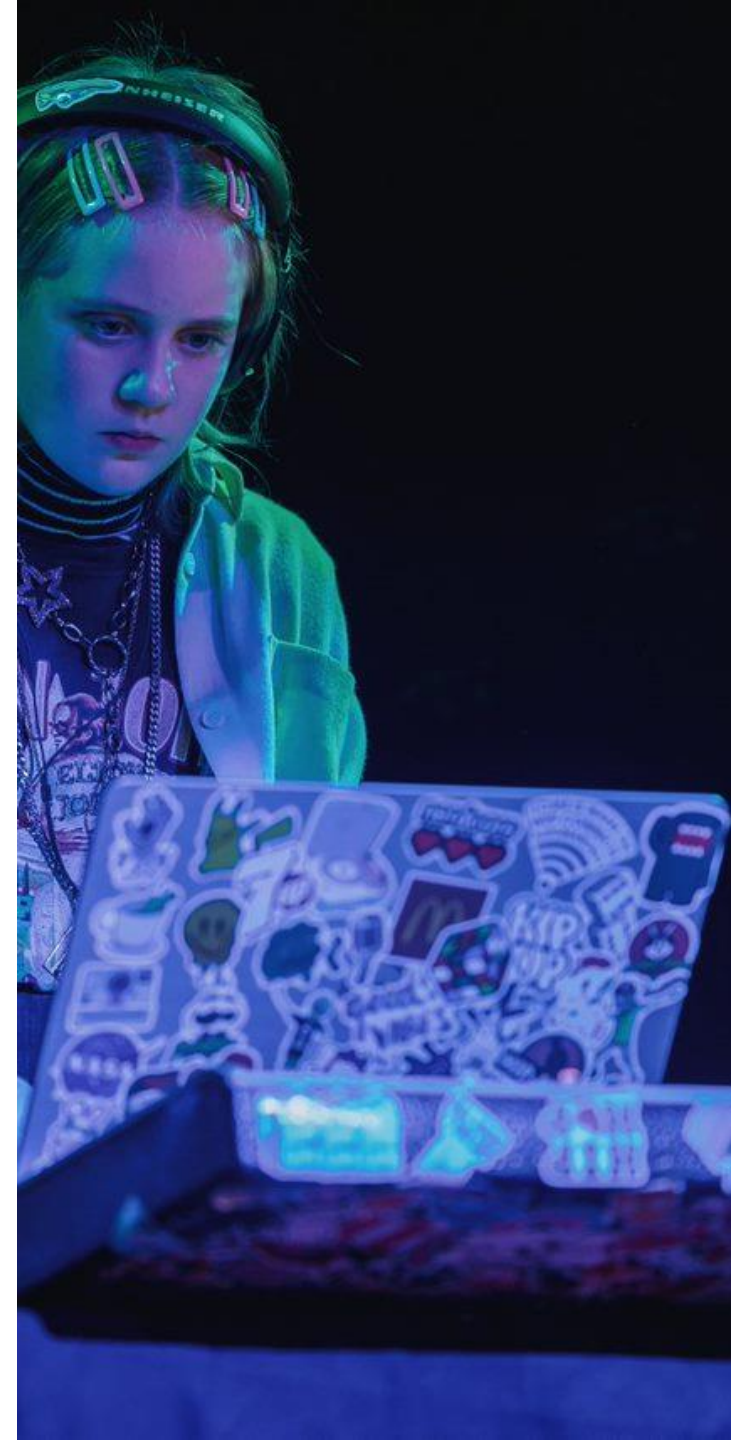

Application – what do you need?

- A good idea for a joint Nordic project
- Partners from 3 different Nordic regions
- Projectplan
- Budget – income and costs
- Criteria for the different grant programs → look at websites
- Check deadlines for different programs

=> Decisions will be made by an expertgroup 8 weeks after DL
